You may already do things in an environmentally friendly way, but may we make some suggestions for your stay with us:-

- Your rubbish will be sorted for re-cycling, but we provide bags for paper, glass and plastics on the first floor landing. Feel free to make use of them.
- We encourage guests to re-use towels which can be dried on the heated towel rails in the rooms. We will then switch off these towel rails when doing the rooms. We will of course replace any towels which have to be left out for washing.
- Electricity can be saved by not leaving lights on unnecessarily, and not leaving electrical devices on stand-by.
- Whilst we try to keep the guesthouse comfortably warm for all, please regulate the radiators in your own room and by all means turn them off if too warm.
- Please consider using public transport whilst on holiday. Many customers arrive by train and then rely on buses and walking during their stay. If you have to arrive by car, why not leave it in the car park and then travel by foot, bicycle, train or bus. We are on the coastal pathways and within walking distance of the rail station.
- We provide information on local producers and their products and hope you will support such businesses during your stay.
